- -Pre Screening- We will screen each patient at the time of scheduling the appointment and at the time of check in.
- -Direct to Room- You will be asked to call us when you arrive and then wait in your car until called. When called the patient will then be taken directly to your treatment room minimizing any unnecessary contact.
- -Protect Yourself- We offer hand sanitizer and a pre procedural rinse.
- -Pre Procedural Rinse- Is an antiviral rinse shown to be effective against viruses
